

Firm Obtains Key Summary Judgment Decision in Connecticut Case

In April, 2012, in an important case of first impression in the Connecticut Superior Court, Cetrulo LLP partner, Matthew Zamaloff, successfully argued on a motion for summary judgment that the Firm's defendant client, Milton Industries, Inc., a manufacturer of multi-purpose blow guns, which did not contain asbestos, did not owe a duty to warn about asbestos in other companies' products even though blow guns were used with motor vehicle parts that did contain asbestos. The case is *Abate v. AAF McQuay Inc.*, Doc. No.: FBT-CV10-60062285-S.
